**WHAT:** REACH is a program where volunteers work one-on-one with an elementary school student. This is a site-based program which provides mentoring and homework assistance to Hispanic children. Many Hispanic children have difficulty at school because they are not able to fully comprehend their homework assignments, and, due to language and educational barriers, neither can their parents. Sessions are held one hour a week and we have an adult staff member supervise and facilitate every session.
