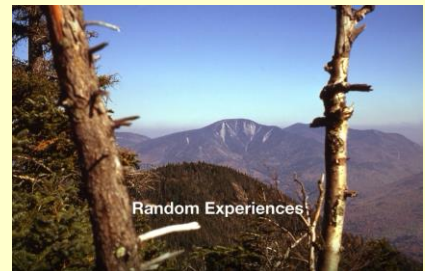

Jim Rogers presented a program with accompanying slide show entitled: ***Random Experiences.***

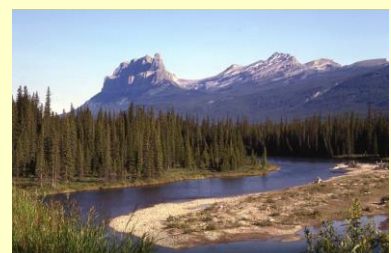

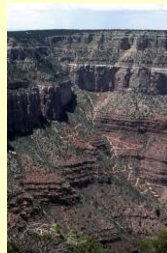
Lonesome Lake, Mt. Hood while traveling to Seattle Washington State to visit family.

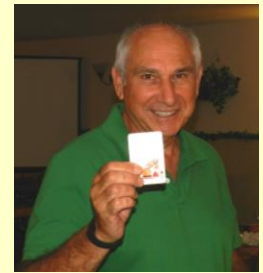
