Peg Weiss and President John introduced the Town of Sand Lake Supervisor Nancy Perry.

Supervisor Perry opened her presentation stating that she has three (3) Ideals that she lives by: Preserve, Promote, & Progress as she



performs her duties in pursuing her goals as town Supervisor.

She stated that she has five (5) Priorities to address over the next several months;

1. Bridging the Gap – Bring the town and its residents together – to work collectively as a team: “Everyone deserves respect”...She will listen to everyone and learn from what is said. The Supervisor wants to establish a Trusting relationship with all citizens. This is a two way street – She will encourage sharing information through additional broadcasts, up-dates to our town website, public meetings...We must improve communication.
2. 2018 Bridge Improvement Program – The town is submitting an application to the State for financial consideration in this program. We have Bridges and Culverts that need attention.
3. Broadband Expansion – Some areas of the Town do not have internet reception...all areas must be connected.
4. Improvements to Butler Park and Town Beach – Improvements Projects have already been started.
5. Making the Right Financial Investments – Putting money where it will accomplish the most for the safety and health of residents is a priority.



A question and Answer period followed the presentation: Questions addressed included the following topics; Arsenic in some town wells, Local business closings, The Town’s Comprehensive Plan, Use of Mobil Station, Traffic congestion at Rt. 43 & Rt. 150, Bridges & Culverts, Emergency Preparedness, Speed reduction on Rt. 351, and the Town’s Beach improvements.

Upon her completion, Nancy was presented with a Certificate of Appreciation.
