Past President Mike Gates introduced himself to the Club and presented a slide show of the variety of birds he has seen mostly in his own back yard, but definitely in our home town. Mike is an excellent photographer and had many close ups of birds at his feeders. He has studied sources and has learned how to



identify the birds he sees. One of the birds we saw was the cowbird, also called the Mafia bird, an aggressive creature who lays its eggs in other birds' nests. The meat eating birds shown were the



American bald eagle, the osprey, the owl, the kingfisher, and the hawk. Mike also had a picture of the snowy owl, taken at Albany Airport. This is a rare sighting, as it is native to the Arctic area. Water birds were ducks, geese, and swans. He also had some amazing close-ups of a feeding hummingbird. Other bird pictures were of the Eastern bluebird,

scarlet tanager, Baltimore oriole, finches, nuthatch, blue jay, cardinal, robin, cedar waxwing, European starling (a species brought to the US that is now a nuisance bird and has multiplied thousand fold), catbird, sparrow, junco, snow bunting, and the woodpecker, who drills holes in trees and sucks the sap until the tree dies. Thank you, Mike, for an entertaining program, with incredible pictures!
