East Greenbush President Lynn Catelotti was honored as a Walter Zeller Fellow for her leadership as VR Division Coordinator for the EliMiNaTe Project, raising \$1250 so far. Lynn reported that KI had so far provided over \$27 million to UNICEF for the vaccination program, and that real progress is being made toward the eradication of tetanus. East Timor, SUB SUB Manis Kiwanis

Tanzania, and most recently China have reported they are MNT-free! Elimination is when the number of cases per 1000 live births in every district is less than 1.

Representatives of both Circle K and Key Club were present and reported on their activities.



PLG Bob Loveridge announced that this year's VR Division Golf Outing will be Sat June 1st at Burden Lake Country Club. The goal is to provide 2 foursomes from each club, in addition to guests from the general public. Play will be scramble format, purpose is to have fun. Dinner at \$25 is separate from the \$100 complete cost for the full day of golf, carts, lunch, and beverages. \$250 fee to BLCC was approved, as was \$150 for startup expenses.

PLG Bob distributed packets of 10 calendars to be sold to help the Rensselaer County Sheriff's K-9 Corps. As they were last year, the calendars not only show some of the dogs with their handlers, but also contain much information on Kiwanis and our projects.
