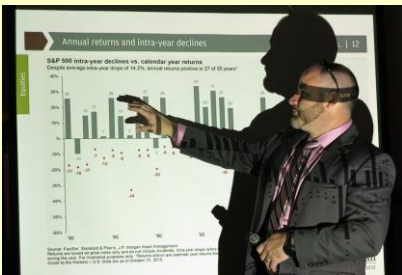


division. You need a balanced

Jerry Tysiak introduced our soon to be new member, Jamie Hanlon, a financial advisor, who would give an illustrated talk on why we should seek the help of a professional when investing our savings. This Editor confesses complete ignorance of this topic, and therefore can only give the barest of reports on what was discussed! Jamie commented that most people based their decisions to buy or sell on their emotions, not on knowledge. There are three types of investments: stocks, bonds, and a 50/50



portfolio, and need to leave your investments in place for a long period of time, i.e. several years. "Cash is not king." Those who save their money in cash, in bank accounts of one kind or another will still have the same amount in the end, but they will not have received any adjustment for inflation, and interest rates are so low as to be negligible. If the Fed raises rates, the market goes up. Jamie provided the members with a printout of the slides he showed. He concluded with the three qualities



needed for successful investing: Quality, Diversification, and Patience! Jamie answered questions from several members, and then Dick Johnsen thanked him on behalf of the club, and presented him with our Certificate of Appreciation.
