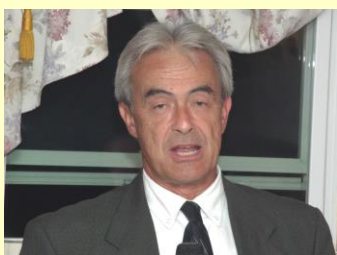

President Jean introduced Bill Dessingue from the ROUSE - RPC (**R**ensselaer **O**rganizations **U**nited for **S**enior **E**ndeavors – **R**ural **P**reservation **C**ompany), a 501c3, not for profit charity, which has four Housing units under its care: Brunswick Senior-Housing in Troy, Brookside Senior-Housing in WSL, Nassau Senior-Housing in Nassau and Blooming Grove Senior-Housing in North Greenbush, where its headquarters are located. ROUSE’s aims are to promote and develop facilities for senior citizens who meet age and income requirements. Its Board of Directors are searching for

volunteer members to join them in formulating policy, direction, and evaluate information, a true governance team. This is not a fund-raising job. Good insurance (D&O liability) protects Board members. They hold 6 meetings per year, lasting about 1.5 hours, plus an annual meeting in December which is a holiday luncheon. There is no specific term; much latitude is given to these volunteers. Bill thanked Kiwanis for all its help to the Brookside residents, particularly helping seniors move in and out of their apartments during the time of renovation. Stu Nippes and Pat Lane expressed interest in joining ROUSE’s Board.

HAPPY DOLLARS

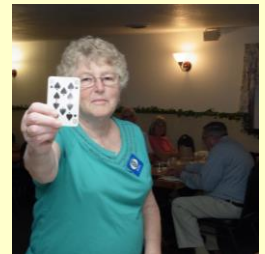
