He presented a video of some of the highlights they saw including the Victor Immanuel monument in the geographical center of the city built on seven hills. They also saw the Temple of the Vestal Virgins, many ruins and forums. After being the center of civilization for many years, Rome became decadent, and fell into ruin in 475 AD. Enough citizens cared, and it was rebuilt, including the Coliseum in 608 AD dedicated to

the reign of Julius Caesar. On the tour were the Temple of Venus and Rome, the Arch of Constantine, the Circus Maximus where chariot races were held, the famous road called the Appian Way lined with cypress trees, the Tiber Island in the middle of the Tiber River which flows through the center of the city, and the Pantheon, originally built as a cathedral, and still in use today, housing tombs of famous Romans.
