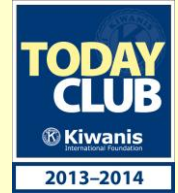
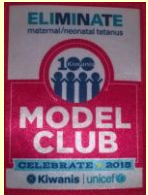

Jerry Tysiak introduced the Town of Sand Lake Supervisor Flora Fasoldt, who explained the Town’s latest project, the installation of attractive welcoming and informational signs. These signs are being created by the artist who did the La Perla Restaurant sign. They will show the separation of the three hamlets, Sand Lake, Averill Park, and West Sand Lake that make up the Town of Sand Lake, and will be the first of several to be created.

Flora passed around a picture of the same type of sign which was done for another community. She also invited those interested to attend a zoning meeting from 6:30-8:30 pm on Tuesday at the Town Hall. It’s to be an open house type of meeting with Monica Ryan and Warren Powers as speakers. There were questions concerning the proposed





natural gas pipe line compressor planned for Clark's Chapel Road just over the town line in Nassau. Maps were distributed showing its proximity to Burden Lake and residences in Sand Lake. A group has been formed called "Save Burden Lake" in protest of this project, and an informational meeting will be held this Wednesday evening at 7 PM at Burden Lake Country Club. This project will

impact several working farms, and many residences, and can cause health and environmental issues. Dick Johnsen thanked Flora for her informational talk, and presented her with our Certificate of Appreciation.
