ENTRIES Solo acts or groups are eligible to enter.
A contestant may enter as a solo act or as part of a group, but not both.
All contestants must be amateurs.
All Acts and guests MUST have a ticket to enter the Pancake Festival.
Tickets are \$6 in advance or \$7 at the door.

AGE GROUPS Contestants will compete in one of four divisions.
A group competes in the Division appropriate for the oldest member of the group.

DIVISION I –	Grades – Pre-K – 1 st -2 nd -3 rd 8:30 a.m.
DIVISION II –	Grades 4 th - 5 th - 6 th 9:00 a.m.
DIVISION III-	Grades 7 th -8 th -9 th 10:00 a.m.
DIVISION IV -	Grades 10 th -11 th -12 th 11:00 a.m.

GROUPS ARE SEPARATE FROM INDIVIDUAL PERFORMERS.

All contestants should check in 30 minutes before their category.

TALENT Acts may be vocal, instrumental, dance, comedy, acrobatics or other performances.
Talent judged on presentation, originality and performance. Decision of the judges is final.

AWARDS This year's awards are engraved plaques for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place in each division.
Individual winners and Group winners will be awarded prizes.

PROPS The stage will be equipped with a microphone, a CD player and if requested early enough a piano. Contestants must furnish their own accompanist, recorded music and other props.

TIME LIMIT Acts are limited to FOUR minutes.

APPLICATION Program space is limited. The contest is open on a first come basis.
Kiwanis reserves the right to reject an act based on objectionable material or safety concerns.
