2007-08 I-I DISTRICT DISTINGUISHED CLUB AWARDS

CONGRATULATIONS to the following 56 clubs of the I-I District received at least 80 points in the Distinguished Club competition for the 2007-08 Kiwanis year.

To qualify for the award, either all 12 monthly reports or the Annual Report must have been filed by the Club Secretary on or before November 14, 2008. Points were awarded by Kiwanis International based on the following achievements as reported by the club:

10 Points were awarded for each of the following **SERVICE** activities:

- The club sponsored one or more SLP clubs (Aktion Club, CKI Club, Key Club, Builders Club, K-Kids Club)
- The club participated in one or more Kiwanis Branded Service Projects (YCPO, BUG, Terrific Kids, etc.)

10 Points were awarded for each of the following **GIVING** activities:

- The club contributed at least \$5 per member to the Kiwanis International Foundation (KIF) Annual Gift Campaign
- The club contributed \$1,000 or more to one of the KIF Hixson Awards programs

Points were awarded for completion of each of the following **MEMBER EDUCATION** programs:

- The Club President attended Club Leadership Education prior to taking office on October 1, 2007 (5 points)
- The Club Secretary attending Club Leadership Education prior to taking office on October 1, 2007 (5 points)
- The club provided a New Member Orientation for every new member inducted during the year (10 points)
- The Club had members attend at least two of the following events (10 points):
 - I-I District Midyear Convention in February 2008
 - The I-I Annual Convention in Peoria in August 2008
 - Attend the Kiwanis International Convention in Orlando in June 2008

Points were awarded for the following **GROWTH** achievements:

- The club membership was at least 1 member more at 9/30/08 than at 9/30/07 (20 points)
- The club membership was at least 5 members more at 9/30/08 than at 9/30/07 (10 additional points)
- The club sponsored and continues to mentor a new Kiwanis Club during the year (20 points)
