

Kiwanis I-I District CKI Scholarship Program 2018

The Kiwanis I-I District has designed a scholarship program to recognize I-I Circle K members who have excelled in leadership and have provided service to others. Financial need is not a factor in this award. Each winner will receive a one-time US\$1,000 award. A committee of Kiwanis District Leaders will determine the winners of the scholarships.

Recipients will be announced at the 2018 I-I District CKI District Convention being held February 24-25, 2018.

Who is Qualified for the Kiwanis I-I District Scholarship Program?

An I-I Circle K Member who:

- has been an active Circle K member in good standing and is a member of a club in good standing with the district and International organizations.
- has paid dues and appears on the roster on file at Circle K International.
- is at least a part-time college student at the time of application and during the fall 2018 period.
- has a grade-point average of at least a "B" average or the equivalent of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- has attached an official college transcript with an explanation of the grading system utilized.
- submits the application to the I-I District Office by February 1, 2018.

Circle K International Board members and current Circle K District Governors are NOT ELIGIBLE for the I-I District Scholarship program.

All scholarships are provided as cash awards in the form of a check issued jointly to the college or university and the student. This check is sent directly to the college or university for deposit into the student's account and most likely will require the student to endorse the check. Checks will be disbursed in Spring/Summer from the I-I District Office. A copy of the letter and check will be forwarded by the I-I District to each recipient for their files.

The completed application form, with required signatures, required attachments and additional required information should be sent to the I-I District Office no later than February 1, 2018. Please make sure that packages arrive on or before this date, as judging will occur the following week.
