2. Make a minimum contribution of \$50 to Special Olympics, issued to your Area Director for use in your locality, the state Special Olympics for use in state-wide events, or the Torch Run for use state-wide, **OR**
3. Sponsor an athlete, or plan some function for a team such as a picnic or attending a sporting event, **AND**
4. **Report these activities on your monthly report under "Youth Services".**
