Hearing Impaired Grant Guidelines and Application

PURPOSE: Grants for a club/Division/District project dealing with hearing impaired children and youth.

PRINCIPLE FUNDING: Donations through the Bo Shafer Fellowship entitled “Bo’s Buccaneers” (Buck-an-Ear) and other Foundation gifts.

GUIDELINES:

1. Priority will be given to projects involving hearing impaired children from birth to age eighteen.
2. The Kentucky-Tennessee District Kiwanis Foundation will consider only grant applications from Kiwanis Clubs within the boundaries of the Kentucky-Tennessee District.
3. Capital improvement requests will not be considered; this includes constructing building and purchasing land. Note that playgrounds and Miracle Fields are considered capital improvements.
4. Grant applications will be accepted for a club/Division/District qualified project for funding up to a maximum of \$1000.
5. The KY-TN District Kiwanis Foundation approves funding of grants once a year during its annual fall meeting. Completed applications must be postmarked by **AUGUST 31** to be considered at the board meeting.
6. Notification of the decision of the foundation board will be made by **DECEMBER 31** following the board’s decision.
7. The decision of the KY-TN District Kiwanis Foundation Board of Directors is final.
8. The KY-TN District Kiwanis Foundation must be named/credited for funding the grant.
9. Grant recipients receive funding as a “one-time” only award.
10. The foundation requires grant recipients to submit a report on the program, including digital color photographs, for publication purposes.
11. Clubs partnering with a non-profit organization will need to complete that section of the application.
12. The club and/or member shall have supported the KY-TN District Kiwanis Foundation during the Kiwanis the previous twelve (12) months prior to the application deadline.
