Student Eligibility

- Have an expressed interest in law enforcement
- Be of good moral character
- Carry an academic grade point average of 2.0 or better
- Be enrolled in grades 10-12 at time of application
- Have no juvenile criminal record
- Pass a physical fitness test

Students are housed at the Michigan State Police Training Academy in Lansing with Police Officers serving as mentors and staff instructors. The instructors come from state, county and local police departments.
