

Interclub

An interclub is a visit by your club to the official meeting of another Kiwanis club or Service Leadership Program club. (K-Kids, Builders Club, Key Club, CKI or Aktion Club). Some Division or District meetings may have an interclub opportunity. If so, the host Kiwanis club will be noted. Two (2) members are needed to constitute an interclub.

Round Robin

A Round Robin is completed when your club has fulfilled the Round Robin requirements listed below. Multiple Round Robins are possible. Forms for reporting Round Robins are available on the District Website under Club Resources and will be mailed to club secretaries. A Round Robin patch is awarded to the club at the following year's Spring Divisional.

- ❖ **First Round Robin Banner Patch: Clubs to do a total of 6 inter-clubs wherein a minimum of 4 to be done within their home division, and the remaining 2 can be within or outside of their home division.**

- ❖ **Second Round Robin Banner Patch: Clubs to do 6 inter-clubs, however 25% (2 inter clubs) must be from clubs outside their home division.**

- ❖ **Third Round Robin Banner Patch: Clubs to do 6 inter-clubs; however 50% (3 inter-clubs) must be to clubs they have not previously visited within the fiscal year.**

- ❖ **Fourth Banner Patch: Completely up to each club to visit 6 clubs wherever they choose to get the 4th Round Robin banner Patch.**
