We are also fortunate to have the renowned pianist, Chancellor Tom George to entertain us at this year's 5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Dinner.

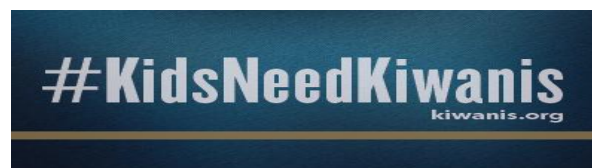
President Ditto reports that he has secured a boat as an attraction for this year's Fishing Derby.
