

Earl Collins Foundation MO-ARK Baseball Raffle

The MO-ARK District is raffling off chances for (1) two tickets in section 147 field boxes behind home plate to the St. Louis Cardinals vs. LA Dodgers baseball game on September 15, (2) a night at the Drury Plaza Hotel in downtown St. Louis, plus (3) a \$250 cash card.

The raffle tickets are \$5 each or 3 for \$10. Rick and Jeanne plan on attending. On June 14 we will have a flying squadron attend the Bridgeton club meeting. Chuck Seevers has volunteered to be the new Region IV Trustee replacing Nancy Willimon. Our club voted to affirm Chuck as our new Region IV Trustee.

Harrison Hong and Carly Herman spoke to us about the Mehlville Key Club accomplishments and plans for next year. They had 25 members this past year and one of their goals is to have more members sign up. Their club helped the activities department at Orchid Terrace Senior Living Center. They sent cards to military veterans. They collected personal care items for Feed My People, worked with us on peanut sales and Salvation Army bell ringing, as well as Reading is Fun. Next year, along with hoping to increase membership, they will hold a Halloween Costume Contest, and they are considering having an additional club meeting before school in addition to their afternoon meeting.

Maxine Taylor and Demi Elrod told us about Oakville Key Club activities. They had between 30-40 members and only lost about 5 members to graduation. This past year they changed the
