### A Garden for Every School

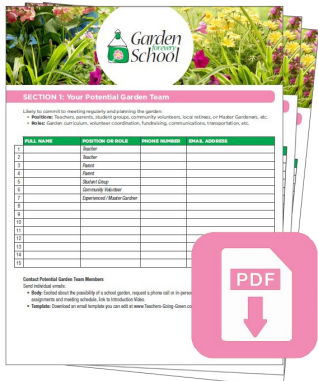
A *Garden for Every School* (AGES) is a free video-training program of Keep Iowa Beautiful that walks schools through every step in the school garden planning process. This program provides 10 short videos, each with a downloadable PDF planning guide to fill out as a team.

Program content comes directly from interviews with school garden coordinators, principals, parents, students, and organizations supporting school

gardens. By combining honest input from real-world experts, *A Garden for Every School* helps navigate the challenges, funding, time-saving solutions of starting a school garden.
