What is the attendance requirements needed to qualify as an interclub?

- An interclub occurs when at least four or more members of your club, or, three members plus one of those listed below, for clubs of 30 or more members visit another club:
- An interclub occurs when at least three or more members of your club, or, two members plus one of those listed below, for clubs of 20 –30 members visit another club:
- An interclub occurs when at least two members of your club, for clubs of less than 20 members visit another club:

Who besides club members can be counted as a member to complete the required number of members needed to qualify as an interclub?

The current Lt. Governor

Each club can use only one of the above to complete the required number of members to qualify as an interclub

What constitutes an interclub?
