## Workshop Descriptions

<b>Youth Protection Guidelines</b>	Attendees will soon better understand what is acceptable and what is NOT acceptable when it comes to interacting with young people under the age of 18. Make sure that your club is in the know!
<b>First Family Project</b>	First Lady Barb will share an update on the First Family Project as well as share some of the success stories going on around the District. This informative session will help you discover some ideas to get involved with this worthwhile endeavor.
<b>Safe and Healthy Kids</b>	Kiwanis Clubs focus on the children in their communities, but sometimes clubs have ideas that their budgets do not support. Join members of the Ohio District Kiwanis Foundation as they share stories of recent grant recipients and how they help kids be safer and healthier.
<b>Partnerships</b>	There are currently several organizations that Kiwanis International partners with that could be providing a benefit to your club. Do you know what they are? This session will help navigate the wide world of Kiwanis Partnerships.
<b>Risk Management</b>	What happens if someone is injured at one of your events or projects? This session will provide insight into the insurance program and how to protect you and your club.
<b>Club Clinic</b>	This interactive workshop will help clubs tackle issues they might be facing. Attendees will be asked to submit questions at the beginning of the workshop, and as the session progresses, the questions will be examined and explored in real time!
<b>Key Club</b>	One of the fastest growing organizations in the Kiwanis Family is Key Club. Join Key Club District Leaders as they educate you on the huge impact that Key Club makes. Tips will also be provided on ways to better interact with your Key Club or charter one in your area.
<b>Aktion Club</b>	Have you ever wanted to work with some of the most passionate and energetic adults in your community? Look no further than Aktion Club. This session will discuss how you can help charter a club in your area, or get more involved with a chapter in your area.
<b>K-Kids/Builders Club</b>	Leadership development begins at an early age. So does an appreciation for wanting to make the world a better place. This workshop will teach you how to provide an outlet to younger students in your community to capture these feelings.
<b>Strengthening your Kiwanis Club through Service Leadership Programs</b>	There are huge benefits to working with SLPs. One of those benefits is that you can have a more well-rounded Kiwanis Club. This session will discuss ways that your club is better off by sponsoring an SLP (or multiple SLPs) and how it will in fact make your club stronger.
<b>Circle K</b>	This college level SLP is growing! If you are unfamiliar with what Circle K is or what impact these dedicated college students have, attend this workshop. Tips will also be provided on how you can support Circle K if you do not have one in your area, or what you can do to get one started.

<b>Key Leader</b>	You may think that you know what Key Leader is...but did you know its undergoing a few changes? This interactive session will help keep you in the know so that your club can provide this experience to high school students in your community.
<b>Brain Charging Stations</b>	One of the most powerful ways to promote early literacy rates is to provide easily accessible reading materials Learn how Kiwanis International has partnered with ReadyNation and the Coin Laundry Association (CLA) to set up reading corners, or "Brain Charging Stations" in communities.

<b>Motivating New Members</b>	It is a struggle for most clubs to keep their current and potential members engaged and ready to serve. This workshop will provide some great tips on getting your members involved and keeping that passion to make a difference alive.
<b>How to leverage Social Media for Growth</b>	Using social media to recruit new members can be tricky. Choose this workshop to learn great tips on setting up your social media presence and using it to leverage higher membership numbers.
