## Kiwanis Birthday-

On January 21<sup>st</sup> Kiwanis International turns 103!

Kiwanis International was founded in 1915 by a group of businessmen in Detroit, Michigan.

The name “Kiwanis” was coined from an expression in an American Indian language of the Detroit area, which means we trade.

In 1987, women were invited to join.

Today, the Kiwanis family is more than 600 members strong and in more than 80 countries.

These are the 6 objects of Kiwanis International, adopted in 1924 at the Kiwanis International Convention in Denver, Colorado and still followed today.

- To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.
- To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.
- To promote the adoption and the application of higher social, business and professional standards.
- To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive and serviceable citizenship.
- To provide, through Kiwanis clubs, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service and to build better communities.
- To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism and goodwill.
