In the past we would make around 200 burritos for the event. This year's after-prom committee said they had comments from the previous year that there was too much food, so they asked us to only make 100 burritos for this year.

It's a little tricky to make an exact number of burritos. This year we made around 120 and after letting the volunteers take a burrito, we ended up delivering around 110 burritos to the parks & rec center.

Maybe it was because the burritos were on top of the food table this year; maybe it was because the coolers were labeled Breakfast Burritos...in any case, the burritos were all gone by 12:30am. I think it's safe to say that next year we will be likely be asked to make 200 burritos again.

This year we used dehydrated shredded potatoes instead of using fresh whole potatoes. This was a fantastic improvement and a huge time saver. The project is always a lot of fun and the burritos are always scrumptious.
