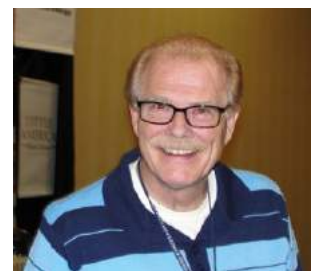

A little about Laramie County Fire District #2

- Largest fire district in Laramie County.
- Calls increased 55% in the past 5 years.

History of Station 2

- Built 1975.
- 1982 they Paved drive way and installed sewer system.
- Over 11,000 new home locations.

Information about Current Station 2:

- There are height and length restrictions
- Lockers are filled to the max
- No sleeping Quarters. Firefighters are sleeping on cots.
- Constant heating and cooling problems, as well as electrical problems.

Why is a new station necessary:

- Current station is over 40 years old and lo longer adequate
- Modern fire/rescue trucks are bigger
- More firefighters who need room
- Modern appliance need 3 phase power
- Suburb areas growing along I-25, Yellowstone Road, and Horse Creek Road

New station 2 would offer:

- Modern efficient fire station.
- Includes 3-phase power capabilities.
- Modern fire/rescue truck bays.
- Accommodates 24/7 staffing.
- Efficient heating and cooking system.
- Better location for improved response.
- Lowered home insurance.
- Main Level – 10,800 sq ft.
- Mezzanine 930 sq ft.
- Basement – 1,340 sq ft.
