Dick has been a member of Cheyenne for most of his life.

Will interest rates ever recover???

Interest rates are historically low, the lowest in the 250 years. Forecasters all missed the mark in projections.

Inflation right now is running 2.75%. The highest CD you can find right now is 2.36%. That is a Negative Interest Rate – you would be losing money.

Why have we seen a 32 year decline in interest: China started to enter the global markets in the 1980's. China has no social security system, no health care, if you go to the hospital you have to show up with cash. Therefore China has a lot of money. On top of that we have emerging countries entering the global world. And in the US we are saving more money.

To get interest rates up we have to get ppl to start spending and borrow more money.

That was a just a couple pieces of information Mr. O'Gara informed us on. Mr. O'Gara gave a great presentation and answered a bunch of questions.

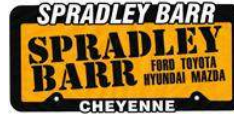
