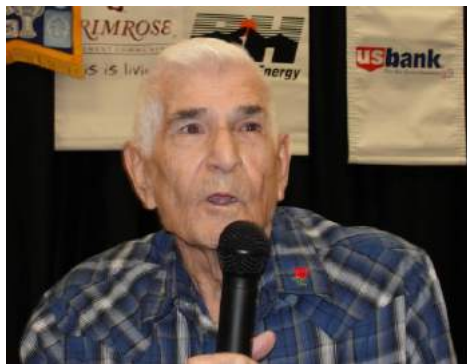

## Friday Food Bag Statistics for 2016/2017 School Year

47 different members - worked 342 hours - at 10 unpacking, 17 fillings, and 34 deliveries  
They unpacked and sorted 275,400 food items and helped place those items in 27,540 bags.

Each bag weighed approximately 3.2 pounds, which for 27,540 bags equals 88,128 pounds, which is just over 44 tons .

Foundation gave a last announcement for the golf tournament June 23<sup>rd</sup>.

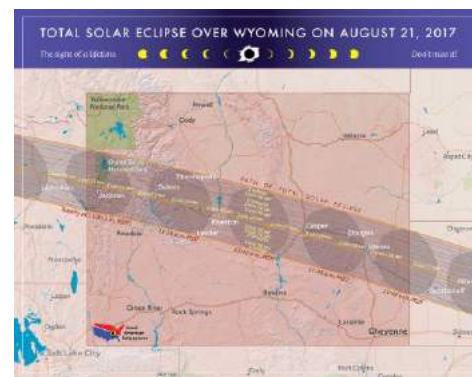
Calcutta is next Thursday, June 15<sup>th</sup>.
