Re-engineering of Crow Creek

With increasing population, encroaching development, and increased water demand has changed runoff patterns, straightened and rerouted the creek channel, increased channel width and decreased depth, decreased riparian vegetation and the list goes on. These impacts have been so dramatic that most people don't even notice Crow Creek passing through town.

Last fall the District was approached by the Curt Gowdy Chapter of Trout Unlimited (TU) to take the lead on a Crow Creek stream restoration project. Their desire was

to provide the best potential stream habitat right here in the capital city for all of the residents to enjoy. The district initiated a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with both the City and the Board of Public Utilities (BOPU) for the ability to perform design work throughout the designated reach which was Happy Jack exit down to Morrie Avenue, roughly 3.4 miles of stream. The MOU was finalized in Resolution No. 5840 during a February city council meeting and the work began.

A committee of federal, state and local agencies, non-governmental organizations, and private citizens was formed to compile a list of goals and objectives for the work to be performed on Crow Creek.

Stream restoration is expensive and an appropriate list of realistic goals and detailed objectives will allow for a better overall design. Their mission statement is "To promote, enhance, restore, and revitalize the ecological values and functions of Crow Creek and its tributaries for public enjoyment". They believe they can safely say that the groups focus is to create a destination for residents to escape our urban setting and enjoy a little recreation right here in town all while providing the best functioning aquatic system that is possible in the confines we're given. Recreation, water quality and stream habitat will be our target.
