### Action Center Year in Review: From Action Center Newsletter

- An average of 460 households served per week, which comes to over 23,940 households served this year.
- Our School Supplies event provided new backpacks and all the essentials for 5,015 Jefferson County young minds to be successful in the 2016-2017 school year.
- Between the two Beautiful Junk Sales, we raised over \$110,000 to help provide services for our participants.
- We were able to help close to 1,500 households and 4,700 individuals receive a warm Thanksgiving meal!
- Santa Shop helped provide 1,486 households and 3,860 individual children gifts on Christmas morning.
- We exceeded our Volunteer Campaign goal of \$25,000 by raising \$26,042!
