## Cleve Interview



Grover C. McKinney, "Cleve" has been a member of Kiwanis of Columbine for the last four years. He was introduced to Kiwanis by Mike Tanner. He is an avid supporter of the Meals on Wheels project with a Wednesday-weekly delivery schedule. Cleve was born in Lake Charles, LA in Sept., 1943. At the time, his mother was living with Cleve's grandparents while his father, a

Coloradoan, was serving in the Army. After the War, his mother and Cleve were reunited with his father in Colorado. He attended elementary, middle and high school in Littleton. He graduated from Littleton High School in 1961. Cleve went on to earn a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Political Science from Arizona State University in 1965.

Cleve married his wife Terri, in 1977, and together they raised six children, Carolyn, Mike, Kim, Jenny, Luke and John. Cleve is also proud of his nine grandchildren, seven of whom live in the Denver area and two others in the Dallas Fort Worth, TX area.

Cleve has had a fulfilling and wide-ranging career. After college, he returned to Denver where he was employed by Shell Oil CO working in Exploration and Production. During his eight years with Shell, Cleve was also based at times in Montana and Louisiana. He returned to Denver from New Orleans where he was employed for the next nine years as Purchasing Manager with Coors Brewery. After Coors, he was employed for ten years as an equipment manager for GOLDCO Industries in Denver. After that, he spent eight years as Purchasing Director with Communications Packaging. Cleve spent the last eight years of his career in sales with Frito Lay before retiring in September 2010.

Within the near future, Cleve plans to fulfill his dream of visiting Omaha Beach where his father was captured during the Normandy Invasion in 1944 and served as a POW.
