Each applicant, in a personal essay, describes the effect that participating in service activities has had on themselves, their school, their community, or the world, while as a high school student. An application, a typed essay of no more than 500 words, a list of activities and recommendations are submitted. There is no grade point requirement. Currently there are two awards available each year at Columbine, Heritage and Littleton High Schools. The applications are reviewed by a committee appointed by the Kiwanis Club of Columbine Board of Directors. The winners are selected, letters with \$500 checks are issued, and a certificate is given to the school to be presented at the school's awards night.
