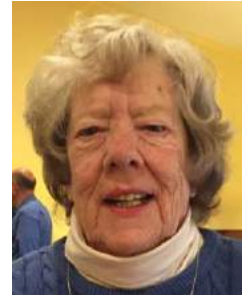
Salvation Army Thank You Breakfast

Meet Eve Trumpore

Eve Trumpore was born in Philadelphia and raised in Atlanta. Her Father, William Van Vleck was an executive with Worthington. Her mother, Eva was the secretary to the Pennsylvania Speaker of the House.



Eve graduated with a B.S. in chemistry from Salem College, NC. in 1959. While in college and after college Eve worked in the Pharmaceutical Industry. In 1961 Eve met Peter Trumpore, an Electrical Engineering graduate of Virginia Military Institute. They were married in 1962. They lived in New Jersey, then moved to Up State New York where their daughter Laura was born in 1964. They moved back to New Jersey where son William "Van" was born in 1967. Then Eve became a stay-at-home mom dedicated to the care and nurturing of her children. Laura is now a supervisor at the Three to Six Ski School in Beaver Creek and Van lives in Littleton, where he works as a Business and Residential remodeling contractor.

In 1971, the family was transferred to Colorado with the Johns Manville Company. Sadly, in 1991 Peter died after a short battle with cancer at the age of fifty-three. For ten years between 2007 and 2017, Eve dedicated herself to volunteer work with Swedish Hospital as well as many other service organizations, in addition to working as a customer service representative for Diners Club.

In 2001 Eve moved to Vail Valley. It was there, while working as a volunteer with the Jerry Ford Invitational Golf Tournament, that she met President Gerald and Betty Ford. Betty Ford invited Eve to tour President's home in Beaver Creek. Eve now proudly displays some Ford family memorabilia in her Littleton home including several posters personally autographed by President Ford and a Chippendale sofa from the Ford Beaver Creek home.

Today Eve continues her lifetime of volunteer work. Sarah West recruited her into the Columbine Kiwanis Club in 2007. Her favorite service project is Meals-on-Wheels. She is also, a very active member and fund raiser for the Philanthropic Education Organization (P.E.O.). Eve's hobbies are playing bridge and sewing.
