Meet Karen Hunley

Karen Hunley was born in Denver, CO in 1950. She was one of two children; her brother Patrick was born in 1949. Her Father served in the Navy from 1941 to 1945. Her mother was a Cadet nurse. Her parents were born and raised in Iowa, but the year after Patrick was born, the family moved to Colorado so her Father could attend graduate school at Denver University. After his graduation, the family settled in Broomfield, CO in 1958.



Karen graduated from Broomfield High School in 1968 and attended Colorado State University in Ft Collins. She graduated in 1972 with a degree in Botany and Bio Science and a Secondary School teacher's certificate. While pursuing her academic curriculum at CSU, Karen also had a job in Plant Pathology working for three years in the University's Greenhouses and labs. One of her most interesting projects was growing test tube baby carnations.

In the summer of 1972, Karen met a young graduate student from the Colorado School of Mines, Rod Hunley, and after a short courtship, they married in 1973.

Karen began her teaching career in the fall of 1972 teaching seventh grade science at Arvada Junior High School. After five years, she left teaching to begin a family. Their son, Dustin, was born in 1977 and their daughter, Kate, in 1980. Between 1977 and 1983, Karen became a stay-at-home mom to care for her children. Daughter, Kate, a journalist by profession, is also now a stay-at-home mom caring for her children. Dustin is a Jazz pianist and teacher.

In 1983, Karen restarted her teaching career at several schools in the JEFFCO school district until she retired in 2016. One of those schools was Columbine High School where she taught biology, chemistry, and earth sciences from 1999 to 2003. She also had to deal with the upsetting aftermath of the school's horrific shooting in 1999.

Karen initially became involved with Kiwanis while teaching through sponsorship of schools' Key Clubs. She became a full member of the Columbine Kiwanis Club in 2000, a few years after Rod Joined the club. While she works on many of the Kiwanis Club's projects, the Key Club is still her favorite. In addition to her Kiwanis projects, Karen still has time to pursue her interests in knitting, sewing, gardening and spending time with her grandchildren.. - Bill
