Meet Our President Elect



Russ Jackson, our President Elect, is due to take over the Columbine Kiwanis Club reins in October. Russ grew up on a farm in Toulon IL. He was the youngest of seven children – five boys and two girls. His father was a farmer, his mother an RN. The family left the farm when Russ was in sixth grade after his father began a career with the U.S. Soil Conservation Service. Russ graduated from Toulon High School in 1973, and went on to earn his degree in Geography and Meteorology in 1977 from Western Illinois University in Macomb Illinois. He left Illinois to attend San Diego University for one year and then moved to St Louis, Missouri for a position with the Defense Mapping Agency.

While at the Defense Mapping Agency, Russ began dating one of his co-workers, Jane, who became his wife in 1985. Russ and Jane have two sons, Adam, born in 1988 and Ben born in 1990. Adam is now a Helicopter pilot with the US army Reserve and is completing training for Certification as a pilot with Envoy Airlines, a regional carrier for American Airlines. Ben is an administrator and instructor at the Leysin American School (LAS) in Switzerland. LAS is an international school in the Alpine village of Leysin that is home to students from six countries. The school is designed to prepare students for universities in the United States.

The family moved to Denver in 1988 where Russ took a job as a Remote Sensing Specialist with the Bureau of Land Management at the Federal Center in Lakewood. Russ retired from the Bureau of Land Management in 2013.
