## Action Center Food Rescue – Oct 7

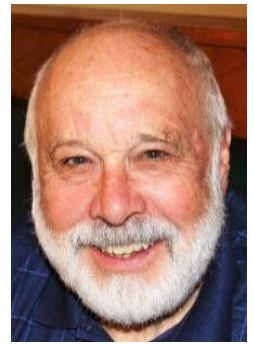
Next Action Center Food Bank is Oct 7. This is the same time as the Second Wind Parking. We need to support both.

## Meet Club Member Bill Duddleson

Bill Duddleson is a Denver area native. His father settled in Denver after being discharged from the US Army Air Corps at Ft. Logan after the end of World War II. He worked at Frauhuf Trailer Corp in Denver. Bill's mother was a home maker. Bill was born in 1946 in what is now the city of Lakewood. He has three younger siblings; two sisters and a brother. Bill graduated from Alameda High School in 1964 and immediately joined the Navy Reserve. He entered active duty with the Navy Seabees in 1965, with the promise of being trained as an electrician. In 1995, Bill met Diane on a blind date arranged while attending his 30th year high school class reunion. They were married in 1996. Between them, Bill and Diane have four children. Bill has a daughter, Lisa and a son, Anthony. Diane has two boys, John and Brian. Together, they have seven grandchildren. Bill enjoys spending time participating in, and helping the grandchildren with their various interests and projects. He is also a woodworking hobbyist and is proud of the Adirondack chairs he has built.

Bill and his friends, George and Hazel Kinzer were originally charter members of the Grant Ranch Kiwanis Club. During his tenure in the Grant Ranch Club, Bill served terms as Treasurer and President. When the Club dissolved in 2014, Bill transferred to the Columbine Kiwanis Club.
