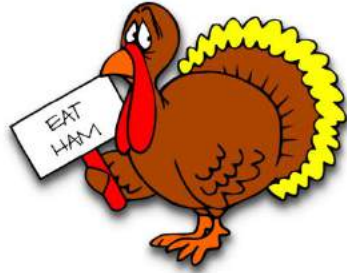

The district foundation also funds (up to \$2,500 per year per project) Kiwanis Club projects throughout the district for which grant requests have been submitted and approved.

Lusche Fellowship in 1992 to pay tribute to the leadership and service of Past International President, Rocky Mountain District Kiwanis Governor and member, Noris Lusche. A contribution of \$1,000 entitles the contributor to either be (or to nominate another person) a Lusche Fellow.

From time to time, our club recognizes the work of an outstanding member through designation as a Lusche Fellow, based upon our club contributions from our weekly game and other contributions. This year, Ken Sweet has been awarded this honor and we thank him and congratulate him on his untiring efforts for our community and our club.
