Meet Tom Powis



It is a chance to visit with present members and to meet potential members.

Tom Powis was inducted into the Kiwanis Club of Columbine on 29 November 2017. He was born in June, 1947 and grew up in the Lansing, Michigan area. His father was a drill instructor in the Army and later enlisted

in Army National Guard where he served for thirty-five years, retiring as Chief of Staff for the State of Michigan. Tom's mother was a buyer for Knapps Department Store. Tom has three siblings, two sisters and one brother.

After graduating from Haslett High School in 1965, Tom attended Michigan State University and graduated in 1969 with a BS in Packaging. After graduation, Tom enlisted in the National Guard. He did his basic training and Infantry Advance Individual Training at Ft. Lewis, Washington. Tom completed his Officer's Candidate School at Ft. Custer in Battle Creek, Michigan and was commissioned as a 2LT, later completing branch qualification for Ordnance Corps and retired as a 1LT with six years of service.

In February of 1970, Tom moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan for employment with Dexter Lock where he served as Packaging Engineer, Marketing Specialist, Purchasing Agent and Production Control Manager. In 1978 after eight years with Dexter Lock, Tom moved to Littleton, Colorado for employment with Johns Manville. He spent four years in Corporate Business Logistics as a Physical Distribution Engineer and twenty-two years in Corporate Purchasing.

Shortly after moving to Colorado, Tom met Cheryl DeWolfe in Littleton. They began dating and were married in 1982. Tom and Cheryl's son James was born in 1984. Tom also has two sons from a previous marriage and five grandchildren. Tom retired from Johns Manville in 2004 when Cheryl began developing serious health problems that required his constant attention. Sadly, Cheryl died in February, 2017 at the age of sixty after a massive stroke.

A few weeks ago, Susan Markley, a member of Tom's congregation at Columbine United Church suggested that he might want to consider joining Kiwanis Club of Columbine. Tom attended a meeting and found that we were such an engaging group that he decided to join. He participated in the Action Center project December 2nd, Salvation Army Bell Ringing on December 16th and is exploring other contributions that he can make to the Club and the community.

Tom enjoys hunting, hiking, fishing and is a long-time golfer. He manages a Senior Golf League at Fox Hollow Golf

Course in Lakewood, CO where he plays eighteen holes every Tuesday morning if the weather allows.

Action Center Food Bank: Saturday, 02/03

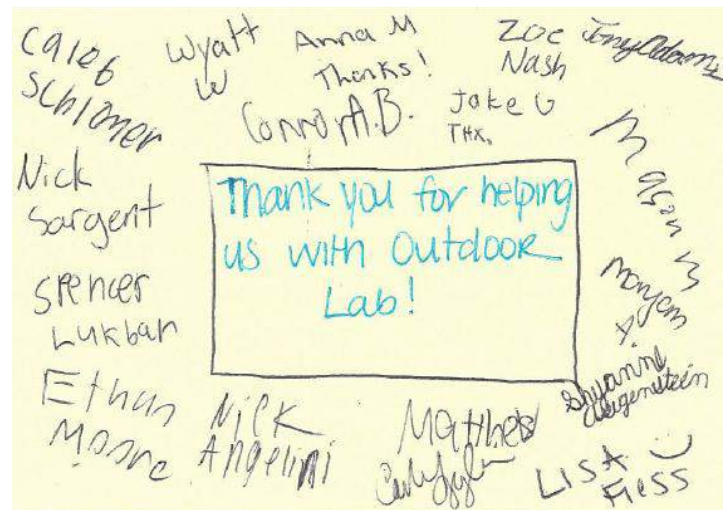
