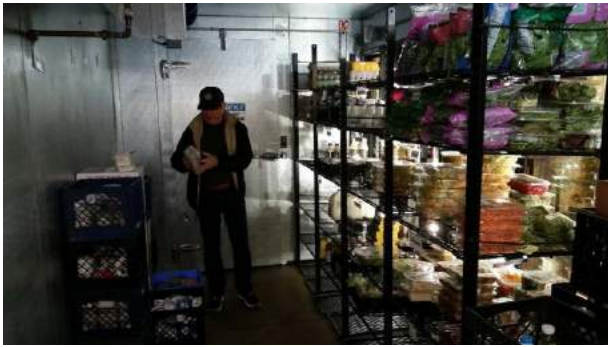
Action Center Food Bank: Saturday, 02/03

closely with the Columbine Club for many years, and previously with the Ken Caryl Club, to coordinate volunteer services at Bandimere. In recognition for our volunteer services, Bandimere gives to our club a percentage of gross receipts for our services.

The money donated to our club by Bandimere Speedway for the Columbine Foundation is the single largest source of funds for the Foundation from outside sources. This is significant in that the money we raise from Bandimere allows our club to fund many of our service projects at the level to which we currently are able.

In the past five years, Bandimere has cut back on the number of charitable organization spots available at their events. However, during this period, Paul has kept our club on the top of his list, and we have even added events to allow us to raise even more money each year. In recognition of Paul and Bandimere Speedway's support for our club, a plaque was recently presented to Paul. Paul's relationship and support of Kiwanis clubs goes back to around 2005.
