Jerry Derr October 13, 1942 - December 21, 2016.

Our member, Jerry Derr, passed away peacefully on December 21, 2016 in his home. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force where he was proficient in the Russian language and during the 1960s listened to and translated Russian radio broadcasts to monitor Russian "Cold War" era military activities. His career continued with "Ma Bell" including time working for U.S. West in Colorado prior to his retirement.



Jerry enjoyed helping others and he practiced this through our Kiwanis Club of Columbine, volunteering for tutoring with kids, helping with the Ronald McDonald House in Denver, Salvation Army Bell ringing, and most of all, Meals On Wheels. His MOW partner, Cleve McKinney, was concerned when Jerry didn't show up for their appointed distributions on December 21 and pursued checking on his welfare through the JeffCo Sheriff Department.

A celebration of Jerry's life was held on December 29 at the Drinkwine Family Mortuary, where family members and friends reviewed significant events and activities of his life. The service was well attended by members of this Kiwanis Club, members of the choir and congregation of Littleton United Methodist Church, the Meals On Wheels organization and others. Speakers at the service included his son Paul Derr, daughter Darlena Murphy, son-in-law Michael Murphy, former spouse Theresa Derr, Cleve McKinney, George Kinzer, Riggs Smith, and representatives of the church choir and Meals on Wheels. Jerry will be missed by many of us.
