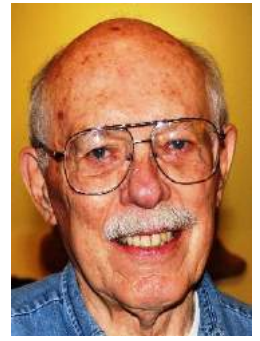

Meet Larry Foos

Larry Foos was born in Greeley, CO. He is one of four brothers. After graduating from High School in 1961, Larry attended Colorado State College in Greeley. In addition to the two years of mandatory Air Force ROTC training, Larry continued with the ROTC program and was commissioned a 2LT upon graduation in 1965.

During his sophomore year in college, Larry met Barbara Ulrich, a freshman. Barbara attended college through Fall, Winter, and Summer sessions to catch up with Larry. She graduated on a Thursday in August, 1965 and they were married three days later. Larry returned to College for the Fall Semester to complete his degree.



Larry was assigned to the Strategic Air Command (SAC) and his first assignment was Kincheloe AFB in the upper Peninsula of Michigan in 1966. Larry was assigned to U-Tapao Afield, Thailand, 1969. Their daughter Sheri was born in 1970 while Larry was serving in Thailand. Larry did not see his daughter until he returned from Thailand when she was nine months old. Their son Loren, was born in Ft Worth, Texas in 1972 while Larry was stationed at Carswell AFB, TX. During his military career with SAC, Larry was the Officer-in-Charge of Aircraft ground maintenance functions for some of our country's most formidable war planes including, the Boeing B52D and B52H Stratofortress, the FB111, and the B1 Bomber.

Larry's final assignment was at the AF Systems Command HQ in Washington, D.C. He retired in 1987. He and Barbara returned to Colorado and settled in Littleton, CO, where he spent another eighteen years in management positions with Continental Airlines, the Douglas County News Press, and finally with Colorado Windows and Siding.

Larry's father-in-law always took him to the Greeley Kiwanis Club when they were visiting their parents in Greeley, CO. When Larry was stationed at Offutt AFB, Nebraska, he was a charter member of the Offutt AFB Kiwanis Club. When he retired from the Air Force and relocated to Littleton CO, he joined the Columbine Kiwanis Club. Larry also volunteers every Thursday at the State Capital providing information and assistance to tourists. Larry and his family are model train enthusiasts, and they host exhibitions of their very impressive model train layout for Kiwanis club members, as well as for school groups. - Bill
