Mike: "I think that what ever we do to cool the Earth, only needs to be a temporary fix..."

The Earth should be headed toward the second half of the Solar- Large Planetary Alignment status where the 4 Gas Giants are more distributed around the Solar system. This lowers the gravitational forces on the Sun, so it gets quieter, and produces a small amount of less energy output. The coolest time period should be about 540 to 541 years after 1680, or 2220 to 2221 as the center of the next coldest year. The coldest period should be around 70 years long from 2185 to 2255 or 2256.

All we have to do is get past about 2050 without broiling the planet, melting all of the glaciers, and raising sea levels, and the natural cooling processes will start to take effect. By then the internal combustion engine will be fading away, and other sources of energy will be used more extensively.
