PROGRAM. Our speaker was **Nancy Harrison** of Colorado Springs Therapeutic Riding Center located at the Mark Reyner Stables in Palmer Park. Although Nancy and her husband have operated the stables for 41 years, they founded the non-profit therapeutic program in 2008. They offer equine-assisted therapy to people of all ages with special needs. Instructors and therapists meet the individual needs of each rider by working one-on-one with them, using the horse as the classroom. They depend on over 100 volunteers to help with clients and they collaborate with organizations including The Resource Exchange, the Cerebral Palsy Association, Downs Syndrome Association, TAPS (a military group) and the Range Riders. They feature an indoor area as well, the “Justin Arena,” named after a little boy with a rare, debilitating, fatal disease. On July 8,

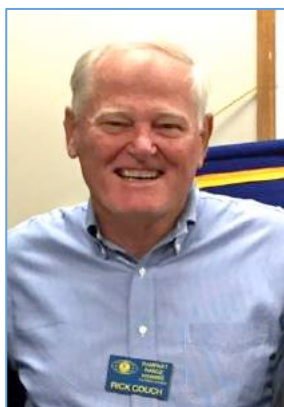
