**PROGRAM:** Retired police officer and historian **Dwight Haverkorn** opened his presentation honoring Deputy **Micah Flick** who was killed yesterday in the line of duty, and then moved to slides of Irvin B. “**Dad**” **Bruce**, Colorado Springs Police Chief, 1941-1960. Born in Missouri in 1893, Bruce moved here around 1900, graduated from Colorado Springs High School and joined the police force. He was respected for his photographic memory in detective work and ability to obtain confessions. He promoted activities for youth including Boys Club and sports events. He was president of the International Association of Police Chiefs, and in 1954, was sent to West Germany and West Berlin by the State Department to assist in the organization of their police departments. As a close friend of **J. Edgar Hoover**, he gained an international reputation. With the opening of Camp Carson (later, Fort Carson) and then the Air Force Academy, he led the city in a time of unprecedented changes. His older son James, a retired attorney, survives in Denver.
