**PROGRAM:** Luke Cammack introduced Family Promise, a nonsectarian, non-profit that partners with over 30 local churches providing shelter, meals, and support services to homeless with children, as part of Interfaith Hospitality Network (IHN). Besides Family Day House, Family Promise collaborates with agencies such as Partners in Housing, Springs Rescue Mission, Catholic Charities, Ecumenical Social Ministries and others. Luke invited discussions about reactions to beggars on the corner and if we've ever known a homeless person. He sees "self transcendence"—moving beyond yourself and helping others find their voice as the highest of callings. The organization is moving into transitional housing and using modular homes to further help families as they prove they are on the right path. He is concerned about the stigma, "not in my neighborhood" attitudes that polarize communities. Family Promise needs
