PROGRAM: **Larry Holdren** promoted the 2018 Department of Defense Warrior Games, to be held this year June 1-9 at the Air Force Academy. Over 300 athletes representing the USA, the UK, Canada and Australia will compete in 11 sports. Larry emphasized that for injured, ill and wounded warriors, this Paralympic-style event is vital to their recovery process. All activities are free and open to the public with gates opening an hour before the events. The Saturday night opening ceremony at Falcon Stadium will be a “quality production” and the concert will feature **Kelly Clarkson**. Larry presented a video depicting a USAF Master Sergeant who lost his leg in Afghanistan and in becoming an athlete, “crashed through barriers” while “redefining what is possible.” Thousands of spectators are expected and volunteers are needed. Go to warriorgamesvolunteers.com. Next year’s games will be held in Tampa, hosted by Special Operations.
