

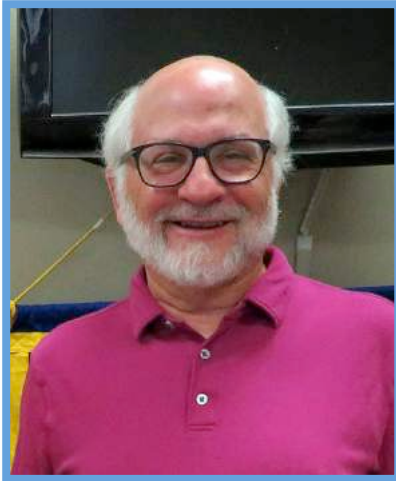

PROGRAM: Executive Director of the Western Museum of Mining and Industry Dr. **Richard A. Sauers** (Rick) presented slides about “The Museum That Works,” with a mission of educating the public about the history of mining in the American West. Open since 1970, and accredited by the American Alliance of Museums, the facility is located on a 27-acre site adjacent to Exit 156 of Interstate 25 on North Gate Blvd. The complex offers visitors a theater, reference library, gift shop and exhibit galleries that contain working engines and mining artifacts. Visitors come for tours from all 50 states and around the world, with about 6,000 school tours, mostly fourth graders studying Colorado history. Increasingly schools are coming from the southern Denver metro area and kids enjoy learning to pan for real gold. The original 1890s Reynolds House is being completely remodeled. We’re invited to become a member, volunteer, sponsor projects, donate, tell our friends, and like the museum on social media. For no charge, we can put up a booth or table at their annual Harvest Festival October 8-9.
