We had several people bring sheet sets, twin comforters, baby quilts and monetary donations, it felt like a big party! Many people see what Sweet Dream provides these children and they give the children their time and donations! Sweet Dream has been able to always have enough bedding for every child that is referred to us! It is amazing! In January over 100 children were gifted with new bedding and by the time February is over we will have gifted more that 200 children (aprox. \$10,000 worth of bedding gifted just in February)!!!
