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ACTIVITY NAME

Homeless Care Kits

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Care kit supplies
- Ziploc bags
- Whiteboard (for discussion purposes)

TIME ESTIMATE

- 1 hour

ACTIVITY SUMMARY

Have students stuff Ziploc bags with homeless care items. During the activity, talk about why homelessness exists in society and ways individuals can make a difference and help. At the end, donate all of the homeless care kits to a homeless shelter. This is a great activity for collaboration between SLPs!

Sample Care Kit Components:

- Gallon size Ziploc bag
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Socks
- Gloves
- Travel size toiletries (conditioner, soap, shampoo)
- Band-aids
- Tissues
- Wet-wipes
- Chapstick
- Deodorant
- Granola bars/non-perishable food
- Water bottle



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Review these questions with the group as a whole. Be sure to allow everyone a chance to speak and share their ideas. Feel free to add any other questions you want to ask as well! The primary point of these questions is to highlight how there is no single leadership style—everyone is different and people look for different qualities in a leader.

- What did everyone think of the activity?
- Why do you think helping the less fortunate relates to leadership?
 - *Write responses on a whiteboard/large sheet of paper
- What does giving back to others say about a leader?
