Club Level

The Club Volunteer of the Year Award is presented to the club member who shows outstanding volunteerism in their community. Involvement in service projects and total service hours should be considered as well as the benefit to the community of these contributions. Each club determines its volunteer of the year. A certificate may be downloaded from the District website under "Awards and Recognition" to present to this Kiwanian.

Division Level

Clubs may nominate a Kiwanian from their club for the Division Volunteer of the Year Award by completing the following form and providing a short two or three paragraph essay explaining why the person was selected. The nomination packet is due by July 15. The Lieutenant Governor will form a committee to select the Division awardee. A certificate may be downloaded from the District website under "Awards and Recognition" to present to this Kiwanian.
